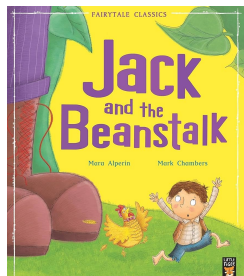
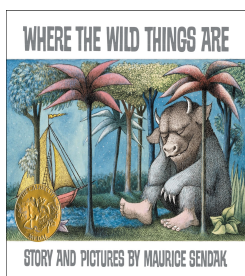

Your child **MUST** read every evening for 15 minutes and record what they have read in their reading record.

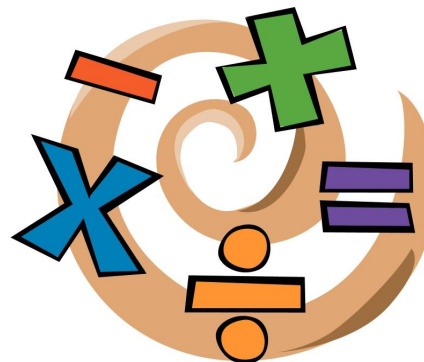

- 2x and 10x tables (multiplication & division facts)



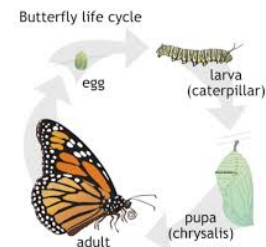
Each week, your child will be set **3 Mathletics tasks** and specific Multiplication Tables to practise on **TTRS** (at least 15 minutes per week)

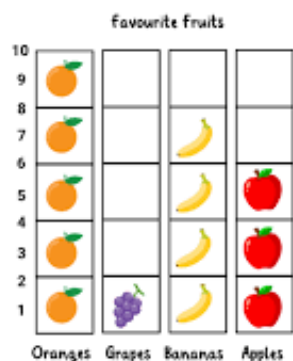

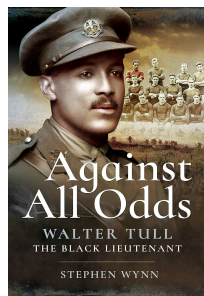
